

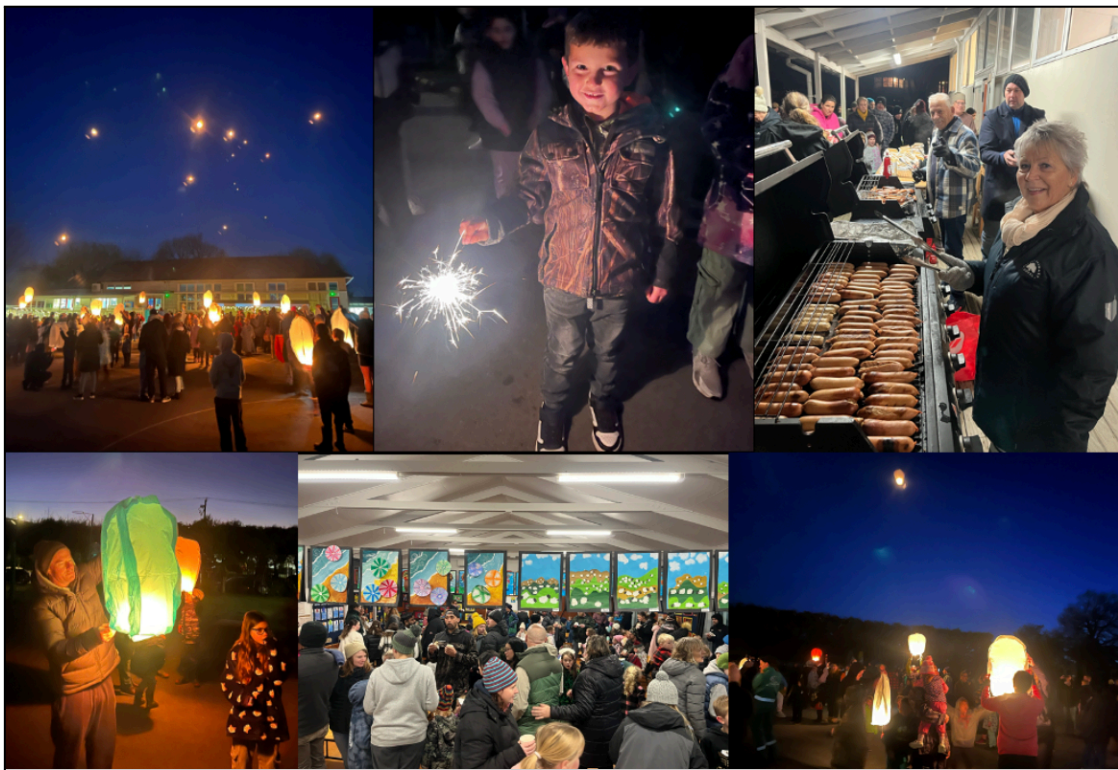

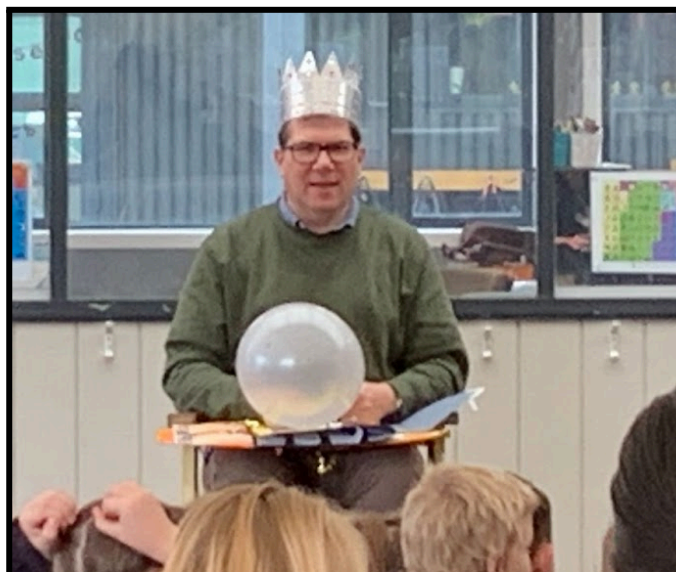


Tumeke Tumuaki - Principal's Appreciation Day
